

Internet Access Information for Parents

In the IB Primary Years Programme, students learn in an inquiry based setting. This requires students to take charge of their own learning by choosing to conduct research in areas of interest. In addition to the books in the classroom and media center, students use classroom computers and devices to access the internet.

Internet access is permitted for academic purposes only and is supervised by teachers and restricted by a firewall.

Students may also access the internet using a personal device. This access must be limited to academic purposes only.

If parents do not wish to permit their children to access the internet at school for academic purposes, they must notify the teacher on the **Internet Exclusion Form**. This form is available in the school's main office.
