# **Student Placement**

At Armwood High School, we believe all students can rise to the standards and expectations set before them. We believe that students can be stretched based on their capabilities, placing them in the best possible seat for their post-secondary options. Therefore, all students' core subjects will be determined by state assessments and course performance. Based on Florida's High School Diploma Requirements, students' electives may also be limited to graduation benchmarks (HOPE, Performing Fine Arts, Intensive Reading). Here is a brief description of some of the advanced academic programs we utilize to fully prepare our students for life.

## Advanced Placement (AP)

Advanced Placement (AP) is a program created by the CollegeBoard; offering collegelevel criteria & skills. Student will have the opportunity to earn college credit, stand out to post-secondary institutions & scholarship selections, and provide students with the needed skills to study and thrive in their education options after high school. While some of our core coursework is completed through AP, students will also have the option to pursue AP, DE, and AICE elective options that match their specific interests.



# <u>Dual Enrollment (DE)</u>

Through a partnership with Hillsborough Community College, high school students are provided with an opportunity to enroll in postsecondary courses, receiving both high school & college credits. We offer a widevariety of Dual Enrollment courses on our campus. Students also have the option to sit for these courses at their local HCC as well! DE coursework requires a 3.0 unweighted GPA; several of the course also requires a College Ready score on PERT/SAT/ACT.



#### AICE

Cambridge AICE (Advanced International Certificate of Education) is an international diploma program created to provide students with a more challenging high school experience & a chance to earn college credit. Our AICE offerings & diploma structure are flexible & allow students to tailor their coursework to their specific interests and strengths. AICE coursework/placement will also be completed by students not intending to pursue the full AICE diploma.
