- 1. As a Collegiate Academy Student, I will be enrolled in my high school courses while also enrolled in Hillsborough Community College (HCC) college credit courses offered at my high school and that the depth, breadth, rigor and pace of these courses will be at the college level.
- 2. Collegiate High School students in college level courses are subject to the same standards, policies, and responsibilities as other college students unless otherwise restricted by federal, state or local requirements.
- 3. Curriculum content, evaluation, and selection of appropriate instructional materials are the prerogative of the college instructor and will not differ for dually enrolled Collegiate High School students from that presented for other college students at HCC.
- 4. Appropriate personnel at my Collegiate Academy is the first point of contact for parents who wish to discuss academic progress in a course, schedule a conference, or request information about school or classroom activities.
- 5. When selected for admission to the Collegiate High School, I must agree to abide by all Collegiate High School and HCC policies and procedures including but not limited to the Student Code of Conduct, Student Progression Plan, course grade requirements, as well as to applicable college policies.
- 6. Completion of high school graduation requirements does not guarantee completion of the AA degree, and I must meet all program requirements identified in the HCC College Catalog at the time of my initial admission.
- 7. While the mission and purpose of the Collegiate High School is to provide accelerated instruction and college level curriculum to motivated students, if my overall college or high school grade point average requirements are not met and if I subsequently do not satisfy requirements as illustrated in my Student Progression Plan, I will be enrolled in courses for high school credit only in order to improve my GPA and my progress toward the high school diploma.
