## Digital Device Acceptable Use Policy

The Hillsborough County Public Schools district has deemed it permissible for students to bring their own digital devices for use in the classroom. Therefore, we have developed a Digital Device Acceptable Use Policy which should make it clear to the students and parents what the expectations will be if they choose to bring their devices on campus.

1. The classroom teacher has the right to approve and /or not approve the use of devices in the classroom.
- 2 Digital devices are to be used only for the reading of school approved material (books, etc.) and not for other purposes such as communication, entertainment, music, gaming, etc.
4. Digital devices must be used at appropriate times in accordance with teacher instructions. The device must not be a distraction for the student or those around him/her nor be a source of any classroom disruption.
5. Digital devices are not to be used during lunch or during teacher directed P.E. times.
6. The student is responsible for knowing how to properly and effectively use their device and this should not be a burden for the teachers.

### Parent/Guardian Agreement

I authorize my child to bring their digital device to Mary Bryant Elementary School with the understanding that it is to be used as a tool for education only and that my child will comply with the aforementioned Digital Device Acceptable Use Policy. I understand that Mary Bryant Elementary School is not responsible for any damage or loss associated with my child's device. I also understand that a violation of digital device policy may result in my child losing the privilege to bring their device to school.
