- 2. Have you tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 10 days?
- 3. Are you currently awaiting results from a COVID-19 test?
- 4. Have you been diagnosed with COVID-19 or been told that you are suspected of having COVID-19 by a licensed healthcare provider in the past 10 days?

If you answered "Yes" to any of the above questions, please do not send your student to school or any school sponsored activity and contact a medical provider.
