N	Needs Improvement/ More Time	Needs additional time or more background experiences before an understanding of on grade-level standards, concepts, ideas, objectives, or academic behaviors taught are attained.
U	Unsatisfactory Progress	Has not yet demonstrated progress towards an understanding of on grade-level standards, concepts, ideas, objectives, or academic behaviors taught.
