

TURNER/BARTELS K-8 STUDENT DRESS CODE AND UNIFORMS

Turner/Bartels K-8 School has a mandatory uniform policy. Our school uniform policy was designed to promote student safety, improve discipline, and enhance the learning environment. All students are expected to dress in uniform every day. Uniforms must fit properly and be neat, clean, and in good repair.

FACE COVERINGS:

- Face coverings will be required when schools reopen for the 2020-21 school year, while on all Hillsborough County Public School property.

UNIFORM SHIRTS:

- Polo-style, solid-colored short-sleeve or long-sleeve shirts in navy blue, maroon or gray are approved.

UNIFORM BOTTOMS:

- Solid tan-colored khaki, black and navy blue shorts, skorts, skirts, and long pants are approved.
- *PLEASE NOTE:*
 - Leggings are NOT considered to be pants.
 - Shorts are to be fingertip length or longer.

DENIM:

- Denim shorts, skorts, skirts, and pants may ONLY be worn on Fridays.
- NO legging style denim is allowed.

SPIRIT SHIRTS:

- Turner/Bartels K-8 school spirit t-shirts and school organization (i.e: Chorus) shirts may be worn ONLY on FRIDAYS.

Modifications to the uniform for religious or health reasons must be requested in writing by a parent through a school administration waiver.
