# HAWL Scholarship

The mission of the Hillsborough Association for Women Lawyers is to promote gender equality in the legal profession and under the law. To recognize and support women for their accomplishments and to assist them as they pursue their educational goals, HAWL annually awards five \$500.00 scholarships. Qualifications include residing or attending school in Hillsborough County, Florida and planning to pursue a career in law or criminal justice. Applicants should have a minimum unweighted GPA of 2.5 or higher and be enrolled or plan to enroll in college or an accredited law school for the 2024-2025 academic year. The submitted personal statement, which is given great weight in the selection process, may be up to 250 words and must indicate a commitment to equality under the law and the promotion of women's issues in the law.
