The purpose of this worksheet is for students to indicate elective preferences for next school year. Students who score below the proficiency level on the Florida Standards Assessments (FSA) in reading and/or math will be scheduled to take intensive level reading and/or math courses in place of electives.

Elective courses are offered based on student interest. Since course offerings, class schedules, and hiring of teachers is based on requests made by students on their programming sheets, it is expected that students honor their commitments next year. Every effort will be made to schedule students for their first choice. However, if a student requests to change selections at a later date, seats may not be available.

Florida law requires physical education for middle school students. The requirement may be waived when the student is scheduled to take intensive reading and/or math courses or the student is participating in physical activities beyond the school day which meet or exceed the mandated requirement. If you would like to request a physical education waiver and/or co-enrollment contract, students must see their school counselor.
