Schedule Change Policy

Student course selections impact the hiring of teachers and the purchasing of textbooks and other resources. In addition, core classes are limited in size by state law. Therefore, adjustments to schedules will be limited as follows:

1. Schedule change requests for core academic courses must be made within the first 5 days of school.
2. Valid reasons for schedule changes include: error, programming: failing a prerequisite course, passing a course in summer, missing a requirement for graduation, or not having the proper prerequisite.
3. Elective changes will not be honored due to teacher unit allocation.
4. Changes will not be considered for teacher preference including "teaching style."
5. Failure to complete summer reading or assignments does not constitute a valid reason for a schedule change.
