- 1. Schedule change requests for core academic courses must be made within the first 5 days of school.
- 2. Valid reasons for schedule changes include: error, programming: failing a prerequisite course, passing a course in summer, missing a requirement for graduation, or not having the proper prerequisite.
- 3. Elective changes will not be honored due to teacher unit allocation.
- 4. Changes will not be considered for teacher preference including "teaching style."
- 5. Failure to complete summer reading or assignments does not constitute a valid reason for a schedule change.
