Reviewing the Course Curriculum Guide

- Students can find page numbers for important information such as:
 1. Student Services Office Information (Guidance)
 2. Graduation/Testing Requirements
 3. Course Descriptions for each course offered at CHS
 4. 3DE Program

Honors and Advance Placement Points

- Honors Points = $+.04$ per semester
- Advance Placement Points = $+.08$ per semester (Students must earn a C or higher in course to receive points)

Example:

An 'A' in English 2 Honors = 4.04

An 'A' in AP World History = 4.08

****These are only used for ranking order. Colleges & universities have their own weighting system for honors and AP courses****

Class of 2025 Graduation Requirements

**Also included in the programming guide AND on front of the course selection sheet

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- 4 Years of English
 - 4 Years of Math
 - 3 Years of Science
 - 3 Years of Social Studies
 - 1 Year Fine Arts
 - 1 Year of HOPE
 - 8 Elective Credits
 - Virtual/Online Requirement
 - (If students plan to attend a four-year college or university, they will need two credits in the same world language)
 - *Students who take and pass two years of JROTC can waive their Fine Arts and HOPE requirement*

- Type last name, first name, and student ID number at the top of the CHS Course Selection Sheet
- Reminder: All academic courses are assigned based on grades, test scores, and teacher recommendation, if applicable

Choosing Classes

- **Choose your top 6 electives**—starting with your most desired elective as your #1 choice; if you have already taken an elective, you cannot take it again.
- **LOOK AT THE LEGEND; some courses require a prerequisite, teacher approval or cost money\$**
- If you choose a semester course, you must choose another semester course to complete a full year. *****This means students need to list two semester (.5) classes on the same line*****
