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Introduction

Reader Response Criticism is a type of literary theory suggesting that readers' perspectives often determine their perceptions. Much as putting on a pair of tinted glasses colors the way you look at the world, critical lenses influence how you study and perceive texts. The critical lens of Reader Response Criticism asks you to be aware of your personal attitudes, beliefs, and experiences as you read. We will be studying Reader Response Criticism during the first quarter.

- 2. Students will *choose one* of the following prompts and write a response that is *at least two paragraphs*:
 - Compare yourself to a main character. Point out your similarities and try to account for differences between you and him/her. Considering what you have discovered, what is your reaction to this character? Why? How do you think the character would feel about you?
 - Explain how a quote from your reading that connects to your life or has meaning for you. What does it mean to you and/or your life?
