### **One-Pager Directions for Marigolds by Eugenia Collier:**

- Prompt: what is the central theme of the text and how do the characters, plot, and setting reveal and shape this theme?
- Design a one-page collage that answers your question using the following:
  - o A thematic statement that represents the reading
  - o Text (two quotes from the reading that supports the prompt).
  - o Two Images (symbols, characters, setting elements, etc.)
  - o Color (think about mood and tone)

### **Netflix (or other) Documentary Directions:**

Write the name of the documentary you watched and then answer these questions:

1. What connections do you draw between the documentary and your own life or other learning?  
Why is this documentary relevant to your life or other learning?
2. What ideas, positions, or assumptions do you want to challenge or argue within this documentary?
3. What key concepts or ideas do you think are important and worth holding on to from the documentary?
4. What changes in attitude, thinking, or action are suggested by the documentary, for either you or others?

### **Research Topic Directions:**

- Think of any, school appropriate, topic that you have always wanted to know about. Research it and write **ten** interesting facts about the subject (and list the website(s) where you found the information).
