WHAT IS EXPECTED FROM YOUR CHILD...

- Students entering kindergarten should be able to identify all letter names when they see them visually.
- Students should know how to write their first name (using upper and lower case letters) independently prior to the first day of school.
- Student will need to be able to use the bathroom independently without any assistance.
- Students are expected to be able to open lunch items independently.
 Please begin to practice lunch manners and table etiquette.
- Students are expected to enter their classrooms independently and put away their own things without assistance.
- Students are expected to know both letter names <u>and sounds</u> by the end of September and be in the process of reading simple words.
- ► Students are expected to be able to read by the 3rd quarter.
- Positive behavior
- ► A sense of wonder and excitement for learning new things. ③



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WHAT IS EXPECTED FROM YOU...

- Encourage positive behavior
- > Ensure that your child is prepared for school each day.
- > Check/sign binder daily
- Read with or to your child every night
- > Have current volunteer form on file if volunteering at school
- Make sure office has current phone numbers, address, emergency contact, and email address
- > Have your child to school on time.
 - > School Opens at 7:10, students are tardy at 7:40 AM.
 - > Be on time for pick-up or arrange for after care for your child.
 - > Monday Early Release Dismissal is at <u>12:55 PM</u>.(TBD)
 - > Tuesday Friday Dismissal is at <u>1:55 PM.</u>
 - > *Keep the **same** dismissal <u>every day</u> for safety and consistency.

What will your child be learning in Kindergarten?

Standards based curriculum for each subject area including:

- ▶ Reading- Reading by the 3rd quarter with comprehension.
- Writing- Writing complete sentences with correct spacing, punctuation and capital and lower-case letters.
- Math- number sense, addition, subtraction, numbers to 100.
- Science- Motions of objects, Properties of Matter, Nature of Science, Earth in Space and Time and Forms of Energy.
- Social Studies-Being a Good Citizen, Holidays Around the World, Calendar, Civics, Geography and Economics

As well as, standards-based instruction for specials classes:

- Art

- > Registration Requirements
- You MUST have the following for your registration to be complete:
- > Child must be 5 on or before September 1st, 2021
- > Original Birth Certificate
- > Social Security Card
- > Current FL Physical with Current FL Shot Record
- Cannot expire before August 10, 2021
- > 2 Proofs of Address

See reference sheet in your folder for acceptable forms

- > Small picture of child, or family photo (optional)
- Any testing information, evaluations for special services,¹⁵ or court documents

Steps to Enrollment

- A parent/legal guardian must complete the registration process and provide the proper documents to the school site where the child will attend.
- Your child can attend kindergarten next August as long as she or he turns 5 on or before September 1.
- Your child is zoned for a particular elementary school based on your address. Find your <u>assigned school</u>.
- For parents who wish to send their child to a school outside of their zoned area, see our <u>choice options</u>.



Documents needed for enrollment

What forms do I need to compete?

- STUDENT Enrollment Record SER (provided at the school site or electronically)
- Student Residency Form (EN) can be completed ahead of time, supporting documentation is required
- KG Questionnaire Link Fill out Incoming Student Questionnaire

and turn in with SER and Student Residency Form.



Documents needed for enrollment (Continued)

What supporting documents do I need to register for kindergarten?

- Birth certificate
- **Social security card**, if available
- Florida Physical HRS Form -- Florida Physical HRS form supplied by a doctor dated within 12 months prior to entry in Florida Schools (first day of school)
- Florida Immunization Record on <u>HRS hard card</u> (form #680) supplied by a doctor
- Two forms of verification of address that prove where you live but are NOT your driver's license or state-issued ID card (some examples are a utility bill, lease, or a contract to purchase a home)
- If a child lives with someone who is not a parent, you may also need to complete a a child care affidavit form, which is available at the school

Head Start

Head Start is a federally funded, comprehensive, child development program that encompasses all aspects of a child's development and learning. The program serves children ages 3 to 4 years old. Eligibility is based on income.
