Purpose:

The purpose of this document is to inform parents and students of the proper manner in which to address concerns and complaints regarding the school, courses and or any IB programme decisions. It is also to inform parents and students of the Hillsborough County Public Schools Student Code of Conduct, Magnet School Compact as well as the Walker Middle Magnet IB Culture of Honor PBIS Plan.

Concerns or Complaints:

- Concerns or Complaints raised should originate with the teacher of the course the complaint pertains to.
- Parents and students can use Canvas to communicate with the teacher and set up a Teams or face-to-face conference if needed.
- If the solutions are not reached between the parent, student and teacher, then the complaint can be brought to the appropriate AP/Assistant Head of School.
- Parent concerns regarding a schedule or student services should be directed to the appropriate School Counselor through Canvas or phone call.
- Student concerns regarding a schedule or student services should be directed to the appropriate School Counselor through Canvas or the completion of a request form located in the Guidance Suite in the Main Office.

Responding to a Concern or Complaint:

- Teachers, School Counselors, Administrators will respond to concerns within 2 business days during regular school hours through Canvas or phone call as requested.
- Teams or Face-to-face meetings will be held as necessary to accommodate families.

Requests for appeals regarding IB decisions taken by the school:

- Students and Parents that have concerns relating directly to IB decisions made by the school can contact the IB MYP Coordinator through Canvas or phone call.
- Head of School will be notified of any concern and will be brought into the communication as needed.
