# Williams Middle Magnet School Model United Nations Team 2021-2022 Information and Application Packet

### What is WMMS Model United Nations (MUN)?

The Williams Middle Magnet School *Model United Nations* ("MUN") team simulates the crucial business of the United Nations assembly. Students role-play UN delegates representing an assigned country. Large-scale university MUN conferences field topics facing the international community. WMMS students serving on various committees engage in pre-conference research on assigned topics, their country's position, and their country's economics, politics, culture, and laws. This work culminates in the two-day conference in New York City at the end of March, in which students participate in diplomatic simulations scored by the chairs of each committee.

## **Benefits of MUN Participation**

Students who participate in MUN gain academic training, enhance life skills, and will:

- Interact and collaborate will fellow academic-driven teammates
- Sharpen negotiations, conflict resolution, and public speaking skills
- Understand critical international issues and gain expanded knowledge of political, historical, economic, and sociocultural issues affecting international member states
- Integrate information across disciplines (geography, government, environmental studies, etc.)

# Part 1: Position Paper due on or before Friday. September 24, 2021 through Canvas message to Mrs. Dunn and Mrs. Dutzar

What is a position paper?

The main point of a position paper is to offer a solution addressing the topic provided. To simplify the tryout procedure, the paper you submit is a little different than a usual position paper for a Model UN conference. Normally, you represent a country; for now, you are speaking for yourself.

<u>Assignment</u>: The United Nations has adopted 17 Sustainable Development Goals, which aim to make the world a more prosperous and peaceful place. Choose one sustainable development goal. Find one-to-two current news events that display the issue this goal attempts to solve. Write a 1 page **position paper** (including citations! Be concise!) which explains the following:

- A short history of the issue
- The issue today
- Solution(s) to resolve the issue
  - o Include 2 current, reliable research sources in an MLA bibliography.

Papers should not exceed 1 pages Anything past one page will not be read. Please use Times New Roman font, size 12, and double-space the essay.

# <u>Part 2:</u> Recorded Speech due on or before Friday, <u>September 24, 2021</u> through Canvas <u>message to Mrs.</u> Dunn and Mrs. Dutzar

Based upon your position paper, prepare a **speech about 60 seconds** in length. Cover the main topics, but *focus most on your solutions*. Your speech should not be you repeating your entire paper. We want to hear you focus on the **main points**. *You will be stopped after 60 seconds*.

 You may use notes, but keep in mind that eye contact and tone are important elements of effective speeches.

#### **Final Results:**

All participants will be notified via the MUN Interest Canvas group whether or not they made it into the MUN Club.
