Close Contact Procedures:

Parents or legal guardians of students who are known to have been in direct contact with an individual who received a positive diagnostic test for COVID-19 may choose one of the following options:

- Call the school and notify us if you choose option B or C
 - A. Allow the student to attend school, school-sponsored activities, or be on school property, without restrictions or disparate treatment, so long as the student remains asymptomatic **OR**
 - B. Quarantine the student for a period not to exceed 7 days from the date of last direct contact with an individual that is positive for COVID-19. Student may return to school on day 8 if they have no symptoms OR
 - C. Quarantine the student for 4 days and the student can return to school on day 5 if they have no symptoms <u>and</u> receive a negative diagnostic test result.
- An administrator will call and confirm return to school date
 - o Day 1 is the day after symptoms started. OR
 - Day 1 is the day after student tested if NO symptoms.
- Student Athletes:
 - o Required to contact their coach
