Dear Alonso High School Families and Staff,

Our top priority is the health and safety of each member of our school family. As such, we want to ensure that we have open communication with all our families and staff members.

We were notified that a **STUDENT** at Alonso High School has tested positive for COVID-19.

You are being contacted because we have identified through our COVID-19 Response Protocol that your student came in close contact with this individual.

Due to privacy laws, we cannot confirm the identity of the individual with the diagnosis. Students and staff who are vaccinated or who have tested positive in the last 90 days are not required to quarantine.

According to Florida House Bill 1B effective 11/18/21:

Parents or legal guardians of students who are known to have been in direct contact with an individual who received a positive diagnostic test for COVID-19 **may choose** <u>one</u> of the following options:

- 1. Allow the student to attend school, school-sponsored activities, or be on school property, without restrictions or disparate treatment, <u>so long as the student remains</u> asymptomatic **OR**
- 2. Quarantine the student for a period not to exceed 7 days from the date of last direct contact with an individual that is positive for COVID-19. Student may return to school on day 8 if they have no symptoms **OR**
- 3. Quarantine the student for 4 days and the student can return to school on day 5 if they have no symptoms and receive a negative diagnostic test result.

If you have already communicated your decision with Alonso High School, no further action is needed at this time. If you need to contact the school with your decision or if you have any questions, please call your student's assistant principal of contact Ms. Omensetter.

It is important to note that COVID-19 symptoms may not appear for up to 14 days after exposure. Please conduct daily health checks with your student daily before they attend school.

If your student becomes symptomatic following direct contact with an individual that has tested positive for COVID-19, or if your student tests positive for COVID-19, they may not attend school, school-sponsored activities or be on school property until:

- 1. The student receives a negative diagnostic COVID-19 test and is asymptomatic **OR**
- 2. Ten days have passed since the onset of symptoms or positive test result, the student has had no fever for 24 hours and the student's other symptoms are improving **OR**
- 3. The student receives written permission to return to school from a medical doctor licensed under chapter 458, an osteopathic physician licensed under chapter 459, or an advanced registered nurse practitioner licensed under chapter 464.

We have notified our District Safety Office regarding our deep cleaning and sanitization protocols.

Thank you for the trust you placed in our schools and in our district.
