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Dear Parents/Guardians of

Thank you for notifying us that **your student has tested positive for COVID-19.**

Your child must now isolate at home for:

- 10 days. Day 1 is the day after symptoms started or Day 1 is the day after they were tested if they have no symptoms **OR**
- Until the student receives a negative diagnostic COVID-19 test and is asymptomatic **OR**
- The student receives written permission to return to school from a medical doctor licensed under chapter 458, an osteopathic physician licensed under chapter 459, or an advanced registered nurse practitioner licensed under chapter 464 and this documentation is shared with the school site.

Consistent with medical expert advice, individuals who need to isolate due to testing positive for COVID-19 should not gather with friends in person, participate in sports or take part in any other activities outside of the home during the isolation period as this increases the risk of spread of illness.

Other household members must be separated from your positive child. Please reach out to **Alonso High School** if you have questions or concerns regarding household separation.

Student athletes are required to complete the return to play before returning to athletics. Please see Alonso website under Alonso Athletics for the form to take to the doctor's office and bring to the athletic trainer. **Contact Ms. Omensetter with any questions.**

During isolation, your child will be able to immediately access learning materials and activities with their current teachers through *Canvas*. Assignments will be uploaded so that your child should not see a disruption in learning. Teachers may also send home printed packets of work for each content area. If your child is not well enough to complete assignments, we will provide them with plenty of time to catch up when they return.

Virtual Quarantine Support enables access to teachers who are available to help students complete their teacher assigned lessons between the hours of 9am – 2pm every day. Teachers are certified and ready to assist our learners who are at home due to quarantine or isolation. *Paper* is a 24/7 tutorial service that is available to students in grades 6-12.

Thank you for the trust you place in our schools and in our district. We will keep you informed and communicate regularly as we strive to deliver the best education for your children, while keeping the health and safety of our student body, staff, and families as our priority.
