Directions:

From the South: Take 275 N, exit on West Hillsborough Ave, then proceed to Alonso High School. Take a right on Montague Street, go around the traffic circle, track/stadium entry is first entrance on the left.

From the North: Take 275 S, exit on West Hillsborough, then proceed to Alonso High School. Take a right on Montague Street, go around the traffic circle, track/stadium entry is first entrance on the left.

Entrance Gate: Athletes ***IN UNIFORM*** and ***Legitimate Coaches*** will enter through the gates to the left of the front ticket booth. Spectators will enter through the gate to the right of the ticket booth. There is no re-entry. Remind your athletes, they must be in uniform to enter the athletic gate. Coaches must be in attire that clearly identifies them as Coaches.

Facility Information (see map)

- Two long jump pits
- Close proximity to shot put/disc/javelin pits (see map)
- Large high jump pad (one gender per time)
- Separated Pole Vault runways (visible from stands)
- Grass javelin runway
- Inclement weather is always a potential in Florida. In that event, athletes will be escorted to the gymnasium or their cars. Fans will be recommended to head to their cars.
- Tent areas are abundant and can be placed around the perimeter of the track, or in the grassy area in front of concessions. Note, the area close to the pole vault runway will be cordoned off to limit traffic.

At the pole vault, an area will be created for coaches and coaches only. Any spectators or parents found in that area will be removed from the facility. The best place to see pole vault will be in the visitors stands. You are right on top of the action.

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KEY INFORMATION:

1. The infield will be closed. Outside of emergency situations, the infield will be off-limits to coaches and athletes not participating in events. **REPEAT ONLY MEET OFFICIALS, VOLUNTEERS and MEET STAFF** will be allowed free access to the infield.
2. In the long and triple jumps, the staggered time sequence of the common schedule should control the traffic at the jump pits. We will be allowing only the gendered competitors access to the pits at any given time. Our sight lines for the jumps are very close to coaches behind the fence.
3. There will be no warmups on the field turf. **Repeat, there will be no warmups on the field turf.** A large warm up area will be provided in the baseball outfield, adjacent to the track. Hurdles will be placed out there for hurdle warm up as well.
4. Primary check in will be at the start of the 100M chute. Field-event check in will be at event-location.
5. Implement weigh-in will be in a tented area close to throwing events. Please advise your athletes to arrive early and avoid any implement weigh-in traffic set-backs. We all know how hectic they can be.
6. Baseball/softball batting cages, diamonds, infields and dugouts are strictly off limits.
7. Javelin guidelines. Per Hillsborough County rules, ALL javelins are to be transported in a hard case, enclosed at both ends. While not in use, javelins are to remain enclosed for security purposes.
8. Viewing areas for the shot put/javelin will be fenced off, viewing areas for the disc will be the tennis courts.
9. There will be a certified trainer located on the infield, near the finish line.
10. Other than check in entrances, gates around the track will be locked. Athletes are **NOT TO JUMP OVER FENCES!**
