Cleveland Elementary Mandatory Uniform Policy

All students are to wear uniforms daily, <u>even on field trips</u>, unless a notice stating otherwise has been sent home from school. We offer these guidelines in a helpful way. Proper dress is conducive to maintaining a positive educational atmosphere.

Allowable Uniform Items

Tops



- Red, White, or Navy Blue
- Short sleeve or long Sleeve with a collar required
- School spirit t-shirts may be worn on Fridays ONLY
- No logo or images printed on shirts
- No hoodies allowed



- \circ Khaki or navy blue
 - Pants, shorts, or capri
- Jumpers, skirts, and skorts must not be shorter than 2" above the knee, measured from the bend of the knee
- \circ $\,$ All pants and shorts must be secured at the waist with a belt $\,$
- No sagging, torn, ripped or cut-off bottoms
- Blue, denim jeans may be worn on Fridays ONLY

Belts

5 Standard, non-decorative belts or buckles

Shoes

- Tennis shoes of any style may be worn
- Loafers or Oxfords
- \circ $\,$ Must be securely fastened and suitable for outdoor activities $\,$
- No open-toe or open-heel shoes

Socks/leggings

Students may wear solid color-no patterned socks or leggings




Head Accessories

Reminders

- \circ All students are expected to be dressed in uniform each day
- \circ $\;$ Blue, denim jeans can be worn on Fridays ONLY with a school spirit t-shirt $\;$
- \circ $\,$ All bottoms must be fitted and free of any holes, rips and/or designs
- \circ $\,$ Non-logo polo tops, bottoms, and any other uniform items may be purchased anywhere you choose
