

COLLINS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Welcome to the 2022-2023 school year! Attached to the front of your postcard you will find information regarding your child's enrollment at Collins Elementary for the 2022-2023 school year. To find your child's teacher(s), look at the address label. You will see a **HIGHLIGHTED** numerical code above your child's last name, this is the homeroom code (HR Code). The three-digit code on the right is your child's room number. **Match the highlighted HR Code with the attached "Homeroom Roster" sheet and you will have your child's grade, teacher's name and room number.**

The first two digits "01" show the child is in first grade (KG indicates kindergarten, 01 indicates first grade, 02 indicates second grade, etc.) The last two digits "01" identify the teacher(s). School starts at 7:40AM on Wednesday, August 10, 2022. The dismissal bell rings at 1:55PM each day (Tues-Fri), dismissal is 12:55PM on Mondays. Breakfast is FREE for all students, beginning at 7:10 each morning. Students may begin arriving on campus at 7:10AM each day. The tardy bell rings at 7:40AM each morning.

On the first day of school, our team members will be posted around campus to direct students to their proper room assignments. We will allow parents to walk students to class on the first day of school, you will not need to sign in. You may only enter through the front doors, near the Office. Starting Thursday, August 11th, only PreK and Kdg parents will be permitted to walk their child to class. **Starting Monday, August 15th, all students will walk themselves to class, parents will not be permitted to sign in to walk students to class. We will have staff posted throughout the campus to assist the students. This is a Hillsborough County Public Schools procedure to ensure the safest environment possible for our students, faculty, and staff.**

For those students who will be riding a school bus, you will find the Collins bus routes on our website as soon as they are available. **During "Meet the Teacher," please be sure to stop by the Media Center to verify your child's placement on the school bus. This is a very important step to ensure your child has bus transportation to/from school.** Please have your child at the bus stop at least ten minutes before the scheduled pick-up time. In the afternoons, please arrive at the bus stop 10 minutes before the scheduled drop-off time.

ALL STUDENTS: Please cut out the "information" form on the attached link and fill in the information. ATTACH THE FORM to your child's shirt or backpack. This information is necessary for student safety and to make the teacher aware of each child's transportation plans on the first day of school.

It is suggested that each student have a backpack (no wheels). This will ensure the safety of school supplies, as well as personal items. **Meet the Teacher Day, an opportunity to meet your child's teacher and drop off supplies, will be Monday, August 8, 2022, from 1PM-3PM. Last names A-L stop by anytime between 1:00-2:00, last names M-Z stop by anytime between 2:00-3:00.** We can't wait to be partners in your child's education. We are looking forward to a RIDICULOUSLY AMAZING year at Collins Elementary!
