All educators in Florida are monitored to ensure they meet certification and training requirements as required by law. Under Florida Statute 1012.42, when a teacher is assigned teaching assignments outside the field in which the teacher is certified, the parents of all students in the class will be notified in writing.

Hillsborough County Public Schools is committed to providing quality instruction for all students and does so by employing the most qualified individuals to teach and support every student in the classroom. The district is assisting our teachers by developing an Individual Professional Development Plan to complete the requirements necessary to enter the field.

All of our teachers are certified to teach, although some of them are currently out of the field and are working in additional areas of certification. You have the right to know the professional qualifications of the teachers or paraprofessionals who instruct your child. Federal law allows you to request certain information about your child's teachers and requires us to give you this information in a timely manner if you request it.
