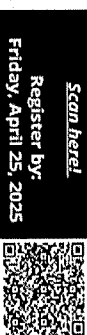

Criterios

- Good behavior*
- 2.5 or higher unweighted GPA*
- Must be in 6th-9th Grade
- Must financially qualify
- *Grades and behavior will be verified through HGPS

Application Process

- Complete online application
- Write an essay on your goals and aspirations
- Submit copy of 1040 Tax Return and copy of Social Security Card
- Participate in an in-person or virtual interview if selected to move forward in the process

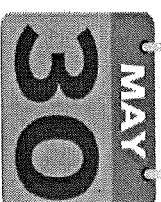
Students enrolled in 6th-9th grade at Hillsborough County Public Schools can apply for a Florida Prepaid scholarship via the Hillsborough Education Foundation's Take Stock in Children program.

Additionally, all Take Stock in Children students will be matched with a volunteer mentor. These mentors will meet with them 2-4 times per month to provide additional support.

Note: Students selected will be eligible to receive a minimum 2-year scholarship.



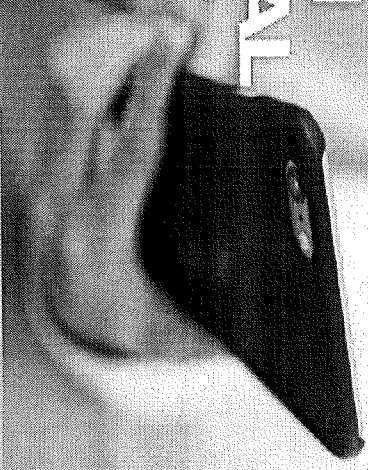
