

Semester exams will be administered to students May 17th and May 18th (**Seniors**) and week of **May 23rd** (**Underclassman**).

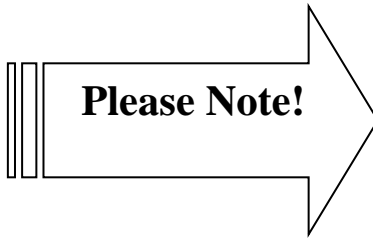

ATTENDANCE DURING EXAMS:



1. Attendance during exams is **MANDATORY**. In the case of illness, a parent or guardian must notify an Assistant Principal for Student Affairs in person or by telephone prior to or **on the same day of the exam being missed**. A doctor's excuse and/or court documentation may be required for the student to be eligible for a make-up exam. Only students whose absences have been cleared by an Assistant Principal will be eligible for a make-up exam. Make-up exams will be administered for those students on the approved list in August.
2. A student truant on exam days will receive an "I" on the exam and will not be eligible for a make-up exam. This results in an automatic failure for the semester.
3. A student who is present but refuses to take a final exam will receive an "I" on the exam. This results in automatic failure for the subject for the semester with **no option** for a make-up exam.
4. During exams, students are **not** to be released from class except in an emergency.
