REMINDERS FROM STUDENT AFFAIRS

Loss of Privileges

- If a student engages in the following behaviors(fighting, drug use, physical attack, battery, threat, vandalism, cursing at staff etc... or any other major behavior incident not defined), the student will be placed on the loss of privileges list, and they will not be allowed to attend after school activities such as sporting events, prom, grad bash. The student can only regain their privileges by meeting with the restorative measures committee to restore their privileges.
- Students with OSS on or after 1/31/23 will not be allowed to purchase tickets for Grad Bash or Prom

Exam Exemptions

• If a student receives a full day of ISS or a student is suspended out of school, the student will not be allowed to exempt their exams.



REMINDERS FROM STUDENT AFFAIRS

Tardiness

 Students must be in class and in their seat when the bell rings to be considered in class on time. If you accumulate too many tardies, you will receive ISS and then you cannot exempt your exams.

Leaving Campus

• Students are not allowed to leave campus during lunch. If you are caught leaving campus, you will be given a day of ISS and then you cannot exempt your exams. If this happens multiple times, we will take away your driving privileges.

Parking

- You must have a parking decal to park on campus. To park in the OJT/Dual Enrollment/Virtual Lot, you must have the appropriate decal. If you receive a ticket, it must be paid in order to receive your diploma. If you receive more than 1 ticket, your driving privileges will be lost for the remainder of the semester.
- You cannot be at your car or anyone else's car for any reason throughout the day.



STATE EXAMS/EOC/AP EXAMS

- Not eligible for exemption
- \$80 fee for missed AP Exams
- \$110 for missed AICE Exams
- Missing a state exam, EOC, or AP Exam may cause your diploma to be delayed. It is very important to sit for these exams!
- EOC Testing: 5/1-5/26
- AP Exams: 5/1-5/12
- Senior Last Day: Wednesday 5/24



FLVS/CREDIT RECOVERY DEADLINE

 April 30th is the last day to complete FLVS and Credit Recovery Courses for graduation!

HOW TO QUALIFY FOR EXAM EXEMPTIONS (SENIORS ONLY)

- No ISS/OSS (even for tardies!) for quarter 3 AND 4
- Three quality point minimum
 - A passing grade for each quarter! No F's!
 - Reminders:
 - You need a D to earn credit for a course, BUT a D calculates as a 1.0 into your GPA!
 - You need a 2.0 to graduate!
- No more than 5 absences (excused or unexcused)
- District exams for seniors will occur Friday, 5/19 and Monday, 5/22.
- SENIOR LAST DAY IS WEDNESDAY, MAY 24th

- I have an F for quarter 4.



DO I GET TO EXEMPT?

WHO GETS TO WALK??

- Students who have met the criteria for a certificate of completion or a high school diploma. You must have 24 credits (unless you are on the 18 credit option) and have completed a program of study.
- A high school diploma = all required assessments taken and passed, 24 credits, 2.0 GPA.
- If you are <u>ONLY</u> awaiting test results for any EOC, you will be allowed to walk.



DEBT

- All debts should be paid off before graduation.
- Debt list will be posted outside of school counseling and updated every two weeks, starting March 1st
- Debts follow you and can be items from middle school.
- Students that have met all graduation requirements and still have a debt are allowed to walk. However, they will not receive their diploma until its paid.
