Who:	K-8: bookmark design (created directly on submission form) 9-12: poster design (8.5" x 11" accompanying submission form)
Criteria:	Submission forms noted above in link as well as attachment. <i>Spanish versions also available.</i> Theme this year: <i>Celebrating Hillsborough's History and Culture</i> National Hispanic Heritage Month 2021 HCPLC
When:	Submission window is open from September 15 – October 15, 2021
Submitted by:	Teacher or student can submit the artwork.

Other Information:	1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd place winner in each of the categories. Each of the bookmark winners would be provided their age group printable bookmarks with HCPLC branding. 1 st place would win \$200 Art Supply Package 2 nd place would win \$100 Art Supply Package 3 rd place would win \$50 Art Supply Package Winners announced by November 29, 2021.
Important things to remember:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Submission must be original work. • Artwork may be color or black and white • Artwork media may include but not limited to: crayons, markers, colored pencils or paints • Because the winning piece would need to be reproduced, consider making artwork vibrant and dark enough to "scan and copy well" • If writing is included, please double check spelling and clarity • Make note of the specific theme focusing on "Hillsborough's" History and Culture
