SCHOOL SUPPLY LISTS

OPEN HOUSE

Open House will be Friday, August 5.

- ✓ Student schedules will be available prior to Open House. Students should bring their schedule to open house.
- √ Various vendor stations will be available in the cafeteria. Please bring \$5 exact change or check made out to Farnell Middle School to purchase agenda planners during Open House. PTSA and uniform purchase opportunities.
- ✓ Please adhere to the times allotted for each grade level.
- ✓ Additional logistical information will be communicated to families the first week of August.

7th and **8**th Grade Open House will be **2:00pm** – **3:30pm**. Students should be accompanied by an adult for self-directed classroom visits.

FARNELL UNIFORM POLICY

Uniform shirts and PE uniforms can be purchased at www.FarnellUniforms.com.

TOPS – Students may wear:

- Red or Black polo WITH or WITHOUT the Farnell logo
- Red or Black dry fit shirts WITH the Farnell logo
- Red or Black t-shirt WITH the Farnell logo
- Red, Black, or Gray sweatshirts preferred, not required
- School Spirit or Club shirts on Fridays ONLY

BOTTOMS – Students may wear:

- Jeans no holes or tears above fingertip
- Pants no holes or tears above fingertip
- Shorts and Skirts must be fingertip length or longer, no holes or tears
- Leggings shirt must be fingertip length over leggings, no holes or tears

Prepare NOW for Basketball Season. Tryouts will begin in August

Tryouts and practices are open to all students who meet the following requirements:

- > 7th 8th grade students must have a 2.0 or higher GPA from the previous semester.
- ▶ 6th grade students are exempt from this requirement for the first semester only.
- > Students must maintain passing citizenship grades thru weekly eligibility forms.
- Three videos, Concussion in Sports, Sudden Cardiac Arrest and Heat Illness Prevention are now REQUIRED videos for ALL students athletes and must be reviewed each year.
- All students/parents must have completed all parts of the athletic packet online at https://www.planeths.com If you have previously done an online athletic packet at planeths.com you can use the "reuse document" button so you now only need to update certain parts of your packet. NO paper forms are accepted. HELP GUIDE: Go to: https://www.hillsboroughschools.org/cms/lib/FL50000635/Centricity/Domain/79/Planeths%20Help%20Guide.pdf
 - Completed application for Athletic Participation
 - Forms can be found at https://www.hillsboroughschools.org/athleticforms
 - Completed physical examination (Form EL 2) Physical must be on the EL 2 Form. Printed and taken to physician then scanned back into https://www.planeths.com
 - Proof of Purchase of Mandatory Insurance Coverage. Cost is \$25.00. Pay online at <u>www.schoolinsuranceofflorida.com</u> or money order (NO CASH or PERSONAL CHECKS). <u>This is non-refundable & required to participate in any extramural tryouts and athletics</u>. Once purchased, it covers participation for that entire school year.
 - Certificates from three required videos
 - Medical Release forms
 - Consent & Release from Liability (Form EL 3)
- All forms must be completed through https://www.planeths.com website. Forms need to be completed only once for the school year to qualify for all sports.
- > Tryouts are scheduled after school and open to all athletes that have completed athletic packets on planeths.com. They are publicized thru mass emails and announcements.

All athletic forms must be completed online and approved by Mr. Fleischmann the Thursday before tryouts begin.

Farnell plays games against other area middle schools in our cluster: Davidsen, Hill, Martinez, Smith, and Walker. Seasons consist of weekly games against each of the above teams (5 games) except Track and Field which consists of a Cluster Meet against all the above teams, and a County Championship for qualifiers. Start time for games is 5:30 on Mondays or 6:00 on Tuesdays thru Fridays. Girls play first followed by Boys. Parents are responsible for transportation to and from game sites.






Creating a Canvas Parent Account
