HS Athletic Eligibility

GPA

- 2.0 GPA (freshmen are automatically eligible 1st semester)

9th GRADE STUDENTS

- All 9th grade students that are regularly promoted are automatically eligible semester 1

RESIDENCE

- Students are eligible to play sports in the school attendance zone in which they reside (some exceptions pertain to Home School and Charter School Students)

TRANSFERS

- Transfer students are only eligible at their new school as long as they enroll prior to the start date of the season

AGE

- Students reaching the age of 19 before July 1st will be ineligible

LIMIT OF ELIGIBILITY

- Students are eligible for 4 consecutive academic years after the successful completion of 8th grade

Athletic Paperwork

- In order to participate in HS Sports, students must create an athletic clearance account at <https://athleticclearance.fhsaahome.org/>
- Make sure to have all required documents on hand and ready to upload:
 - Physician Physical (on correct FHSAA EL2 form)
 - Birth Certificate
 - Proof of Residence (current TECO/Water bill or lease/mortgage statement)
 - 3 NFHS Required Courses (Heat Illness, Concussion, and Sudden Cardiac Arrest)
 - Parent Government Issued ID
 - School Health of Florida Insurance Card
 - Residential & Enrollment History Form
