# STUDENTS WILL HAVE TWO CLASSROOMS AND TWO TEACHERS.


- Mrs. Biella teaches Reading, Writing, and Social Studies.

# CONSEQUENCES FOR BEHAVIOR

- 1. Students will be given a warning.
- 2. Students will earn a number written in their agenda.
- 3. Family will be contacted.
- 4. Students will get a checkmark on their behavior sheet.
- 5. If a student has 4 or more check marks in one area, they will receive an indicator on their report card.

# READING

- Florida's B.E.S.T Standards for Reading
- Curriculum used includes Wonders, I-ready, SIPPS, and other supplemental resources
- Students will read a variety of texts to practice decoding, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension skills.

# WRITING

Students will use a variety of writing routines:

- Plan writing
- Write a draft to include a topic sentence, details, and a closing sentence
- Revise/Peer conference
- Edit (capitals, punctuation, spelling)
- Publish/Present

First quarter will focus on one complete paragraph and second quarter we'll move into multiple paragraphs.

# MATH CURRICULUM

- We use EnVision by Pearson Math books, I-Ready lessons, and other supplemental resources.
- Our standards are broken up into 4 domains:
- 1. Operations and Algebraic Thinking
- 2. Numbers and Operations in Base Tens
- 3. Measurement and Data
- 4. Geometry
- The students will take a Math Monthly assessment that will be based on prior units.
- The students have a data log in their binder to track their test scores.
