Registration for Kindergarten is Open!

To register you must have:

1. Child's birth certificate or approved evidence of birth.
2. Health report with physical exam within twelve months prior to the first day of attendance in a Florida school.
3. Immunization record (5-DPT, 4-OPV, 2-MMR, and 3 Hepatitis B series, 2 Varicella)-or disease verified by parent or physician OR a medical exemption signed by a doctor OR a religious exemption on HRS Form, 681 available at a Hillsborough County Health Dept.
4. Two Proofs of Residence (Drivers License, TECO or water bill, lease/mortgage agreement, property tax receipt, homestead exemption, or warranty deed)
5. Child's social security card.



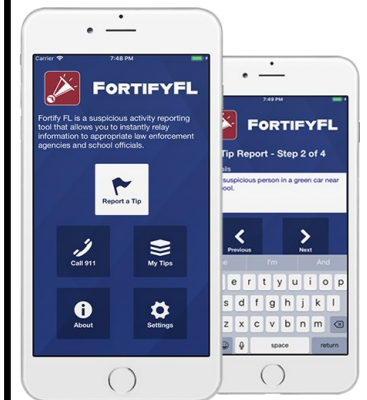

School Safety is our Priority!

The State of Florida developed the “FortifyFL” app where students can report suspicious activities instantly to the appropriate law enforcement agencies and school officials.

If you do not have access through your phone or a computer, please let your child’s teacher know and we will provide a printed copy for your family. Your information goes to:

- **Your School Officials:** The tip report goes to your local school officials when submitted.
- **Local Law Enforcement:** Your local police department or sheriff office receive copies of your tips automatically.
- **Site-Level Officials:** Site-level officials also have access to your tips to make sure proper steps are taken.



Cell Phone Policy



Students bringing a cell phone to school is a parental choice. Cell phones are not to be turned on or used during school hours. They should not be visible during the school day. If this policy is not followed, there will be a warning the first time and the second time the cell phone will be sent to the office and a parent/guardian will have to come to the school to pick it up. Please help our students focus on their learning.
