2023-2024 School Year

Instructional program for Pre-K children!

Eligible children must turn four years old between February 2, 2023 and September 1, 2023 and not previously participated in a Kindergarten or VPK program.

Registration available in the school office.



Note that NO transportation will be provided and HOST, our after school program, does not accept 4-year old students.

Kindergarten Registration

Register now for 2023-2024 School Year

If your child will be 5 on or before September 1, 2023 they can start school in August.

To register you must have:

1. Child's birth certificate or approved evidence of birth.
2. Health report with physical exam within twelve months prior to the first day of attendance in a Florida school.
3. Immunization record (5-DPT, 4-OPV, 2-MMR, and 3 Hepatitis B series, 2 Varicella)-or disease verified by parent or physician OR a medical exemption signed by a doctor OR a religious exemption on HRS Form, 681 available at a Hillsborough County Health Dept.
4. Two Proofs of Residence (TECO bill, lease/mortgage agreement, property tax receipt, homestead exemption, or warranty deed)
5. Child's social security card.
