The holidays can be an exciting time for students and families. However, the holidays can also bring awareness to mental health needs. Here are some quick strategies to keep you and your child healthy over the winter break:

- Keep a regular sleep schedule
- Keep expectations manageable for you and your child
- Be mindful of stressful situations for your child
- Spend time with supportive people
- Be aware of warning signs
 - Excessive worrying, feeling excessively sad, extreme mood changes, avoiding friends or family, increase in irritability or hyperactivity, increase in nightmares, or changes in eating habits
- Seek help if needed
 - —Crisis Center of Tampa Bay (Call 2-1-1)
 - —National Alliance on Mental Illness (Text "Helpline" to 62640 or call 800-950-NAMI)
 - Suicide and Crisis Lifeline (Call or text 988)
 - 911 in case of an emergency

If you do not have access through your phone or a computer, please let your child's teacher know and we will provide a printed copy for your family.


Your information goes to:


- Your School Officials: The tip report goes to your local school officials when submitted.
- Local Law Enforcement: Your local police department or sheriff office receive copies of your tips automatically.
- Site-Level Officials: Site-level officials also have access to your tips to make sure proper steps are taken.



Steps To Create "Here Comes the Bus" (HCTB) Account

- 1. Download and install "Here Comes the Bus" app from Apple App Store or Google Play.
- 2. Click Sign Up! button (near bottom of page) to create your account.
- Click "I have the Code". Type your email address, first and last name and school district code 75255.
- 4. If terms are acceptable, click the "I Accept the Terms of Use Agreement radio button then click continue"
- 5. Create your password and confirm. You will receive an email to activate account.
- 6. Use your credentials to login and add your students. Must have student ID to add with student's last
