Students do not need to bring a backpack or any other materials on the last day of school.

Registration for Kindergarten is Open!

To register you must have:

- Child's birth certificate or approved evidence of birth.
- 2. Health report with physical exam within twelve months prior to the first day of attendance in a Florida school.
- 3. Immunization record (5-DPT, 4-OPV, 2-MMR, and 3 Hepatitis B series, 2 Varicella)-or disease verified by parent or physician OR a medical exemption signed by a doctor OR a religious exemption on HRS Form, 681 available at a Hillsborough County Health Dept.
- Two Proofs of Residence (Drivers License, TECO or water bill, lease/mortgage agreement, property tax receipt, homestead exemption, or warranty deed)
- Child's social security card.
