Registration for Kindergarten is Open!

To register you must have:

- 1. Child's birth certificate or approved evidence of birth.
- 2. Health report with physical exam within twelve months prior to the first day of attendance in a Florida school.
- 3. Immunization record (5-DPT, 4-OPV, 2-MMR, and 3 Hepatitis B series,2 Varicella)-or disease verified by parent or physician OR a medical exemption signed by a doctor OR a religious exemption on HRS Form, 681 available at a Hillsborough County Health Dept.
- 4. Two Proofs of Residence (Drivers License, TECO or water bill, lease/mortgage agreement, property tax receipt, homestead exemption, or warranty deed)
- 5. Child's social security card.



2024-2025 School Year

Instructional program for Pre-K children!

Eligible children must turn four years old by September 1, 2024 and not previously participated in a VPK program.



Note that NO transportation will be provided and HOST, our after school program, does not accept 4-year old students.

School Safety is our Priority!

The State of Florida developed the "FortifyFL" app where students can report suspicious activities instantly to the appropriate law enforcement agencies and school officials.

If you do not have access through your phone or a computer, please let your child's teacher know and we will provide a printed copy for your family. Your information goes to:

- Your School Officials: The tip report goes to your local school officials when submitted.
- Local Law Enforcement: Your local police department or sheriff office receive copies of your tips automatically.
- Site-Level Officials: Sitelevel officials also have access to your tips to make sure proper steps are taken.

Summer Lending Library

The lending library serves as a place for parents, grandparents, or any community member to borrow books to read at home with their child and extend literacy beyond the school day.

- Bring your certificate to the VPK school to finalize the process and secure a summer VPK seat at that site.


To apply online, parents will need the following:

- An active email address
- A digital copy of proof of your child's date of birth and proof of your Florida residency
- Access to a printer to print out your VPK Certificate of Eligibility (COE)

Child must be 5 years old or turn 5 on or before September 1, 2024. Child may not have previously attended a VPK Program during the school year
