Our gates open at 7:10 each morning and close at 7:40 when the bell rings. **Students need to be in their seats at 7:40.** When planning your morning, it is best to arrive at school no later than 7:35 to give your child time to get to class. Morning Arrival

This year, Yates Elementary will be implementing a few school wide attendance incentives!


