#### **NEW SIGN-IN/SIGN-OUT PROCEDURES**

Parents and guardians will not be permitted to enter the building for sign-ins and sign-outs.

#### Sign-ins Procedures

1) Escort student to the main doors,

2) approach ticket booth, to the left of main entrance doors,

3) inform the office staff that you are signing student in. 4) Student will be let in and parent/guardian is free to leave.

Sign-outs Procedures

1) Approach ticket booth, to the left of main entrance doors,

2) inform the office staff that you are signing student out and, 3) parent's/guardians will be required provide ID to office staff for verification.

4) Once verified by office staff, parents/guardians may return to their vehicle to wait for their students to be released.

## **DISCIPLINE POLICY**

## TARDY POLICY

I understand that school starts at 8:30 AM every day. Any student arriving after 8:30 AM will accumulate a tardy upon entering class. When a student is more than 15 minutes late to school, they must sign-in at the Ticket/Sig-in/Sign-Out Booth.

- Tardies are counted on a cumulative basis per nine weeks. 1. 2. All students are to be in their classroom-assigned
- instructional area when the bell rings.
- 3. Tardies will be computed on a quarterly (nine weeks) basis for all classes.

# **PROHIBITED ITEMS**

Hats, headphones, gang related items, laser lights, noisemakers, confetti toys and SKATEBOARDS, etc. are not permitted in school. Items will be confiscated and student will be referred to Student Affairs Office for disciplinary action. Parents will need to pick up confiscated items in Student Affairs Office by the end of each semester or items not picked up will be donated to charity at the end of the year.

## DRESS CODE POLICY

Students violating dress code: pants not at waist, illegal shirts (tank tops, no bare shoulders, excessive cleavage, bare mid-driffs), head coverings (no du-rags, hats or hoodies in classrooms). shortshorts and mini-skirts, clothing with inflammatory or derogatory language, pajamas, house slippers, wallet chains, leggings without shirt covering that is finger-tip length, bandanas, etc. will be assigned discipline.

- Student must change clothes each time they have a dress code violation. If they cannot comply, they will NOT be permitted back into class.
  - Ist Offense- Conference w/ student and change of clothing
  - Ind Offense- Conference w/ student, parent notification, change of clothing, and 1 Day of ISS
  - 3rd Offense- Conference w/ student, parent notification, change clothing, and 2 Davs of ISS
  - 4th Offense- Mandatory Parent Conference and 1 Day of OSS
- > If no change of clothes; student remains in ISS.
- > All boys' shirts must have sleeves.
- > No excessive tears/rips in pants/shorts above mid-thigh.

# **ELECTRONICS POLICY**

Student the privilege of using electronics including head phones before and after school, during lunch, and during passing periods. \*Should this privilege be abused, Admin reserves the right to revoke this privilege at any time. \*

Cell phones may not be used in classrooms unless in an approved BYOD (bring your own device) classrooms for instructional purposes and the YELLOW sign is up. Our policy for the return of cell phones that are confiscated is as follows:

- 1st Offense- Phone confiscated (returned at end of the a. period by teacher); Parent Notification
- 2nd Offense- Phone confiscated (returned at end of day by b. Admin); Parent Notification
- c. 3rd Offense- Phone confiscated (parent pick up required): Parent Notification

NOTE: Refusal to hand over electronic device is considered **DEFIANCE** and will result in additional disciplinary consequences.
