Physical Education Waiver for 2020 – 2021

In 2009-10 Florida Senate Bill 610 established a waiver process to provide students an opportunity to select an elective in the place of P.E. if they were required to take a remedial course in reading/math or the student had outside physical activities that were equivalent to the P.E. requirement. This legislation was not intended to provide an early release time for students. All middle school students are required to take seven class periods each day. Students have the option of taking one of the seven courses using the virtual school option. All students with a PE waiver must either be enrolled in seven classes per day at the school site or be enrolled in a combination of school site courses and virtual school courses (HVS or FLVS). Florida law requires students to take one semester, or the equivalent, of physical education in grades six, seven, and eight. To request a waiver for this requirement, complete this form and return it to Ms. Rappleyea by **July 10th**.

***Please note, if a 6th Grader opts out of PE, there is NO alternative elective class for them to take. They will be released early and required to take a virtual class.
