10 STEPS TO PREPARE FOR THE ACT EXAM

1. Get to Know the ACT

- a. <u>The ACT Test Overview</u>
- b. Create/access <u>MyACT</u> account to access ACT quizzes, test questions, ACT Question of the Day
- c. <u>ACT Reporting Category</u>
- d. Interactive Student Score Report and Sample Student Score Report (PDF)
- e. How Do Tests, Questions, and Reporting Categories Relate to One Another?

2. Understanding ACT Standards and Setting Goals

- a. ACT College and Career Readiness Standards English, Reading, Math
- b. How to use the ACT College Readiness Posters- Available to print
 - i. Posters can be used to:
 - 1. Relate test scores to the skills needed in high school and beyond
 - 2. Communicate widely shared learning goals and expectations
 - 3. Understand the increasing complexity of skills needed across the score ranges in English, mathematics, reading, science, and writing

3. ACT PRACTICE TEST

- a. Provide a practice test opportunity start by taking a <u>practice test</u> (Preparing for the ACT) to understand strengths and weaknesses
 - i. Administer over multiple days, if appropriate
 - ii. Answer key located behind Preparing for the ACT booklet
 - iii. Review with students

4. SCORE AND REVIEW

- a. Refer to ACT Student Report
- b. Explore free ACT resources to find practice material
 - i. Check practice test score against ACT College and Career Readiness Benchmarks for a better understanding of performance
 - **ii.** <u>CCR Benchmarks</u> are performance standards, representing the minimum ACT test scores required for students to have a reasonable chance of success in first-year, credit-bearing college courses.
- c. Register students for free Kaplan Free ACT Events
 - i. Sign up and receive the ACT Question of the Day for daily practice

5. ENGLISH

- <u>ACT Question of the Day</u> for daily practice.
- Take ACT English Half-Length Practice Test
- 6. <u>MATH</u>
- ACT Question of the Day for daily practice.
- Take ACT Math Half-Length Practice Test

7. <u>READING</u>

- ACT Question of the Day for daily practice.
- Take ACT Reading Half-Length Practice Test

8. SCIENCE

- <u>ACT Question of the Day</u> for daily practice.
- Take ACT Science Half-Length Practice Test

9. SCORE REPORTS

- a. Students should review PreACT or <u>ACT Score Report</u> (if they have taken the ACT) for insights into reporting categories and the number of questions per category.
- b. PreACT tests can be administered

10. PACING

- a. Timing their responses might help with pacing
- b. Include questions/quizzes
