

Cambridge Advanced International Certificate of Education Diploma Program

The Cambridge AICE Diploma is an internationally recognized diploma awarded to students for the satisfactory completion of a series of academically rigorous courses specific to AICE in high school. To earn the AICE diploma, students will need to complete and pass at least 7 AICE courses and exams from different categories (Mathematics and Sciences, Languages, Arts and Humanities and Interdisciplinary and Skills-Based Subjects). The AICE program is described as a rigorous course of study, preparing students for life and college at a more intensive pace than traditional coursework.
