Brandon EPIC3 Center Dress Code

Dress Code Will Be Strictly Enforced (School Uniforms are to be worn by all students)

The uniform consists of the following:

- Polo Shirt: Appropriate color is by grade level - Middle School- Hunter Green. High School Students - Navy Blue, and Credit Recovery Students – Burgundy.
- Optional: Students may wear one white t-shirt under the polo shirt. No other shirt should be worn. The uniform is to remain on students until they arrive home at the end of the day.
- Denim (jeans) or khaki material (shorts, pants, skirts, or dresses are allowed to be worn. Please keep in mind, dresses must still be worn with the appropriate uniform shirt.
- Pants must be secured at the waist with a belt, no under garments showing.
- No yoga pants, leggings, tights, spandex, **sweatpants**, or sleep attire are allowed to be worn at any time. This includes **NO** rips/tears, no skin above the knee showing.
- Jackets without a hood and front zipping (no pull overs) and No head coverings are allowed. This includes bulky headbands!
- Head covering, caps and hoods will not be allowed on campus.
- No bandanas, if found they will be taken by staff and not returned.
- Gloves and hat are only allowed on campus when the temperature is 50 degrees or lower at time the student is searched.
- No sandals or shoes with spikes or wheels. All students are to wear a close toe shoe.
- Miniskirts, mini dresses, and short shorts are not permitted: They should be 2 inches BELOW the longest fingertip when held to the leg. Dresses, skirts, long pants, and shorts are not to have revealing slits up the side, back or front.
- Garments and jewelry which display or suggest sexual, vulgar, drug or alcohol related wording or graphics which provoke or may tend to provoke violence or disruption in the school shall not be worn.
- Designer items and jewelry are encouraged to be kept at home. Students will take full responsibility for the safe keeping of these items if they choose to bring it to campus.
- Wallet chains, rings that are attached (brass knuckles), or hair picks are not allowed on campus.
- No purse, cross body bag or any type of bag is allowed on campus.
- No food is allowed out of the cafeteria.
- Only ear buds/headphones & PBIS point sheet will be carried on the campus.
- Feminine hygiene products are provided by the clinic staff. Individual preference and specific brands preferred can be provided by the student/family for use when at school.
