

5TH ANNUAL SAFETY PATROL

WHITE ELEPHANT GIFT EXCHANGE

Playing the game of "WHITE ELEPHANT"

- Bring a wrapped gift (\$3 - \$5 in price)
- Draw numbers to determine the order of gift choosing
- Sit in a circle with all gifts in the center for all to see
- The person who drew #1 selects a gift and opens it for all to see
- The person who drew #2 decides whether to steal that gift or choose another from under the tree
- The game continues, with each person getting a chance to steal or choose their own to unwrap
- When there are no more unwrapped gifts, #1 gets one last turn. If they decide not to steal the game is over. If they do steal, the game continues until someone decides to keep their gift

Rules of the game:

1. Each gift can only be stolen three times in the game.
2. Each gift can only be stolen once per turn.
3. Everyone who has had a turn must have a gift. For example, if you took the first turn and your gift was stolen, you must unwrap a gift. As the game goes on, stealing gifts turns into swapping gifts, so everyone should have a gift at any given time. So, if you take Sally's box of animal crackers, you have to give your flashlight to her.
