Please read the following expectations and then sign

EXPECTATIONS OF A BUCKHORN SAFETY PATROL

1. The patrol's job is an EVERYDAY JOB. A patrol will serve the entire year.
2. Campus Safety Patrols are expected to sign in and then be on post no later than 7:15 am.
3. Campus Safety Patrols will be on post in hot and cold weather.
4. All Safety Patrols will wear their patrol belt and badge every day while performing their duties.
5. All Safety Patrols will obey all school rules and be role models to everyone.
6. Bus Patrols will assist the bus driver in maintaining order and enforcing other safety rules.

DISCIPLINE SYSTEM

- This is a 3-6-9 "you're out" shot system
 - 3 shots = 1 strike
 - First strike = loss of belt for 1 week
 - Second strike (3 more shots) = loss of belt for the remainder of the quarter but no less than 2 weeks (depending on where strike falls)
 - Third strike (3 more shots) = loss of belt and patrol position for the remainder of the year and student will not be allowed to attend annual patrol picnic at Medard Park
 - *Shots reset at the end of each sign-in sheet but strikes do not*
- Ways to receive shots
 - Signing in late/being on post late
 - Not signing in
 - Not bringing or wearing your belt on post/bus
 - Being rude or disrespectful to fellow patrols, fellow students, or teachers
