Students will begin school on **Wednesday, August 10, 2022**. Regular school hours are 7:40 A.M. until 2:35 P.M. **Due to student safety, students may not arrive on campus prior to 7:10 A.M.** Students are marked tardy after 7:40 AM. Free breakfast will be served daily from 7:10-7:40 A.M.

The Car riders will be dropped off and picked up on the Yukon ramp this year, which was previously the bus ramp. **PLEASE DO NOT USE THE UPPER OR LOWER CAMPUS TO PICK UP AND DROP OFF STUDENTS.** If you are picking your child up early, then please use the Upper Campus Ramp. Late students will also be dropped off in the morning on the Upper Campus.

Bus routes and schedules will be released soon. Bus riders are expected to be at the bus stop 10 minutes before the specified pickup time. Student safety is paramount, and students will be asked to read and sign a Bus Behavior form acknowledging the expected behaviors to remain safe to and from school. **Kindergarten riders must have an adult waiting for them every afternoon or they will be returned to school.** It is then the parent/ guardian responsibility to pick up that student.
