

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Welcome to the 2020-2021 school year! Attached to the front of your postcard you will find information regarding your child's enrollment at Collins Elementary for the 2020-2021 school year. To find your child's teacher(s), look at the address label. You will see a HIGHLIGHTED numerical code above your child's last name, this is the homeroom code. The three-digit code on the right is your child's room number. Match the homeroom code with the attached "homeroom roster" sheet and you will have your child's grade, teacher's name and room number.

The first two digits "01" show the child is in first grade (KG indicates kindergarten, 01 indicates first grade, 02 indicates second grade, etc.) The last two digits "01" identify the teacher(s). The first week of school (8/24-8/28) will be eLearning for ALL students. More information will be sent via Parentlink messages. On August 31, 2020, brick and mortar students will return to the school building. School starts at 7:40AM for all students. Each Monday is an Early Release Day for all students; dismissal is at 12:55PM. Dismissal on Tuesday-Friday is 1:55PM. The lunch price is \$2.25; breakfast is FREE for all students. Brick and mortar students can arrive for breakfast beginning at 7:10 each morning. Feeding schedules for eLearning students will be sent via Parentlink messages. Under no circumstance can students arrive on campus prior to 7:10AM. If you need morning care for your child, please register them for morning HOST. Information can be found at hillsboroughschools.org, search HOST.

Our brick and mortar students will return to Collins on Monday, August 31st, our team members will be posted around campus to direct students to their proper room assignments. Due to COVID, visitors are not permitted on campus. Unfortunately, parents will not be allowed to walk their children to class. THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED for the safety of our students and staff. This is a district wide requirement. We know how difficult this will be for many families; we are here to support you to ensure your child's safety. We will assist them in getting to the proper classroom.

For those students who will be riding a school bus, you will find bus route information on our website. If you have any questions about transportation, please call 813-840-7308. Please have your child at the bus stop at least ten minutes before the time scheduled.

ALL STUDENTS: Please cut out the "information" form on the attached link and fill in the information. ATTACH THE FORM to your child's shirt or backpack. This information is necessary for student safety, to make sure they make it to the right class, and to make the teacher aware of each child's transportation plans.

It is suggested that each student have a backpack (no wheels). This will ensure the safety of school supplies as well as personal items. MARK YOUR CALENDAR - Meet the Teacher Day, an opportunity to meet your child's teacher, will be on Friday, August 21st any time between 1:00PM-3:00PM. Zoom links will be emailed to parents and will be available on our website via live link. The password for all zoom links is panthers1.
