Don’t Forget the Uniforms

Colson Elementary School is a mandatory school uniform school. Colson’s Uniform Policy requires the following unless you request exemptions due to a religious or other substantial reason(s) discussed with Administration in the Opt-Out Process (Opt-Out Forms are available in the main office).....

Tops...

- Polo Collared Short-Sleeve Shirts in Green (Hunter Green) or Maroon (Burgundy) or White
- Botton-down shirts/blouses in Green (Hunter Green), Maroon (Burgundy) or White

Bottoms...

- Pants that are Khaki, Navy Blue or Blue Jeans
- Shorts that are arms-length (put arms to side and the shorts come to finger-dips or longer) and are Khaki, Navy Blue or Blue Jeans in color

Shoes...

- Closed-toe Shoes – no specific color, no slippers, thongs, flip-flops....for safety purposes shoes must be fastened not slip-on
