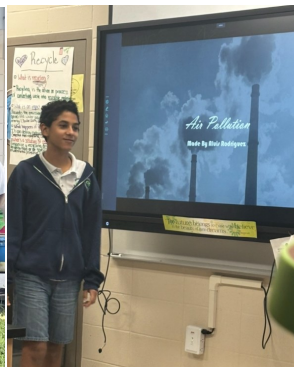

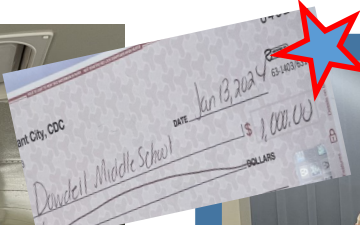




DMMS DRUMLINE

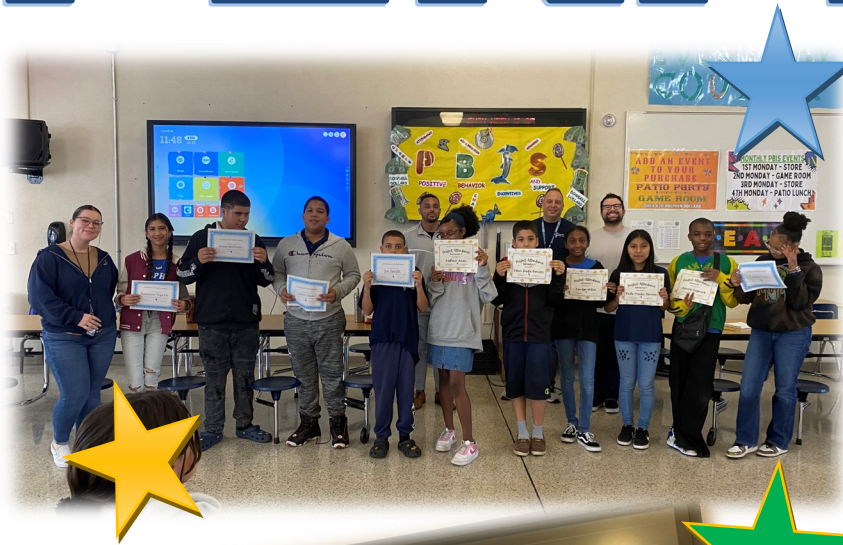
