

mmunization Requirements for Entry Into Florida state schools 7<sup>th</sup> - 12th grades

The Florida Law is requiring that students entering seventh through twelfth-grades receive a very specific form of the "Tetanus" vaccine. This vaccine is referred to as the **Tdap** (Combined Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis Vaccines). This requirement is in addition to the previous immunization requirements that are age-appropriate. Recommendations for provision of the Tdap vaccine are in accordance with the recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP).

Documentation from the student's health care provider should specify that the student has received the Tdap vaccine on the Florida Certificate of Immunization (680 form).

Students who cannot receive the vaccine due to medical contraindications must present a permanent medical exemption from the medical provider on the Florida Certificate of Immunization (680 form). Students that have a religious exemption must provide the DH 681 that can be obtained at the Health Department.

Three additional vaccines are not mandated, but parents are encouraged to discuss them with their child's physician. These are: the meningococcal meningitis vaccine, Hepatitis A series, and the HPV vaccine series (now approved for both males and females).

#### Additional Immunization Recommendations:

Four vaccines which are not mandated for your child's grade level, but are recommended by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) should be discussed with your health care provider are: meningococcal meningitis, hepatitis A series, Influenza and Human Papilloma (HPV) Vaccine series.
