Grade point average - average of all your grades



**State-unweighted
District-weighted, Honors, AP, and
Dual classes are weighted more**



**4 points awarded to A, 3 to B, 2 to C,
1 to D, 0 to F**

**D's give credit but do not give quality points for
GPA**

Semester Exams



Quarter 1 + Quarter 2 + Semester Exam = Final Grade

Quarter 3 + Quarter 4 + Semester Exam = Final Grade

Your final grade comes from the combination of quarter 1, plus quarter 2, plus your semester exam. The final grade is what will be added to your GPA

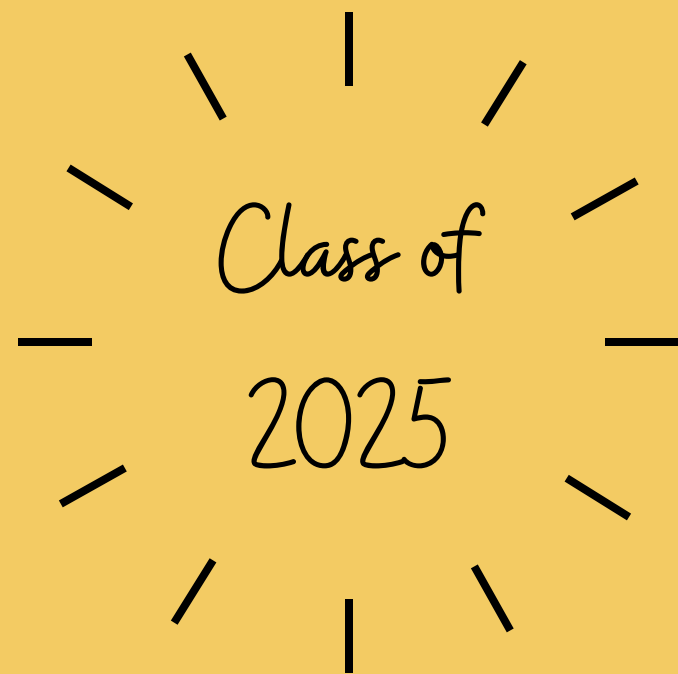

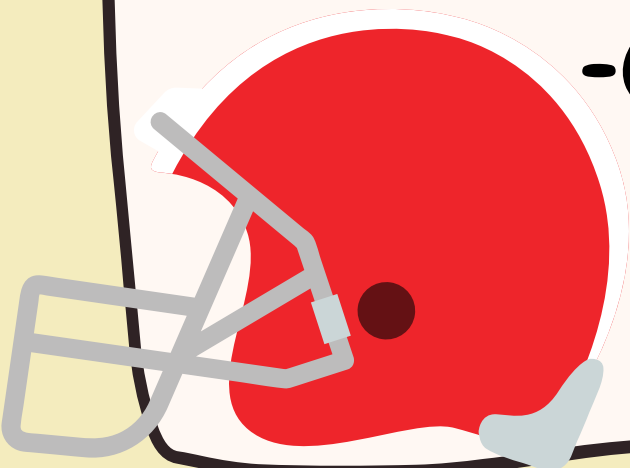

Scholarships

- Scholarships are available for students of ALL grade levels. You can start applying as early as 9th grade.
 - The District Scholarship Matrix comes out the 1st week of every month and lists scholarships, the amount, the requirements, and the deadline to apply
 - The matrix can be found on Canvas, EBHS website, and the district website
- National scholarship sites such as FastWeb and Raise.Me also offer scholarships for all grade levels
- Any scholarship that requires you to pay or become a member to apply is a SCAM!!
Stay away!

Bright Futures

- Florida State sponsored scholarship
- Allows Florida residents who attend any post-secondary institution (trade/technical school, community college, college/university) to have a portion, or all, of their tuition paid for by the state
- Requires a specific GPA, number of credits, SAT or ACT score, and community service hours
- **All grades matter 9th-12th !!**





Community Service



- There is no community service requirement for graduation
- However, most local scholarships require community service hours and college applications almost always ask how you are involved in your community
 - Community service guidelines can be found on the Florida Bright Futures website
- Profferfish – district platform used to find, request, and record community service hours
- Incoming 9th graders will not have access to the Profferfish platform until the new school year begins in August 2021
- If you are interested in beginning to perform service hours during the summer you must contact Ms. Felix for approval PRIOR to June 3rd. If you do not get approval from Ms. Felix you run the risk of your service hours not being approved when you submit them later on.

Have a 3.0 unweighted or higher HIGH SCHOOL GPA

Complete Application online

PERT/SAT/ACT test scores submitted (take exam at/with HCC)

Form B completed by School Counselor and submitted to HCC

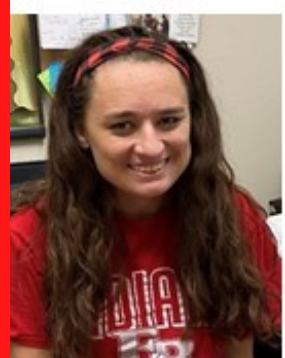
